3M China Among Top 100 Green Companies for the 4th Year In line

3M made the 2012 list of “China’s Top 100 Green Companies” for the fourth year in a row, and was ranked among the top 10 greenest foreign enterprises in China by the Daonong Centre for Enterprise and Green Herald Magazine.

May 4, 2012, Shanghai—3M has been named to "China's Top 100 Green Companies" for a fourth year in a row. The Top 100 Green Companies in China is released annually by Daonong Institute in associate with Green Herald Magazine. The 2012 list was announced at a ceremony on April 22nd.

The "China's Top 100 Green Companies" list is known for its strict selection process. Enterprises that made the 2012 ranking were chosen through an online vote and subsequently reviewed by an appraisal panel. List qualification is based on a comprehensive review of business performance from five criteria including economic results, contributions to society, environmental impact, innovation and transparency. It also reflects responses by companies to the challenges they faced over the previous year in the quest for sustainable development.
