

Anoop Sondhi, D.D.S., M.S.



Dr. Anoop Sondhi received his dental degree from the Indiana University School of Dentistry, and his post-graduate certificate and M.S. in orthodontics from the University of Illinois in 1977. Following his graduation, he was on the graduate faculty of the Department of Orthodontics at Indiana University. During his full-time academic appointment at Indiana University, he maintained a part-time private practice. Since 1988, he has been in full-time private practice in Indianapolis, and continues as a Visiting Professor for several graduate programs in orthodontics. He has presented seminars and continuing education courses to several dental and orthodontic organizations in the United States, and has been invited to give courses in Canada, Central America, South America, Europe, the Far East, South Africa, Australia and New Zealand.

In his orthodontic practice, Dr. Sondhi devotes a significant amount of his work to the development of effective and efficient treatment systems, indirect bonding, interceptive treatment of complex malocclusions, and the orthodontic management of temporomandibular disorders. In addition, he teaches courses on practice management, office organization, and staff management. Dr. Sondhi has also served as a consultant to the American Journal of Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics.
